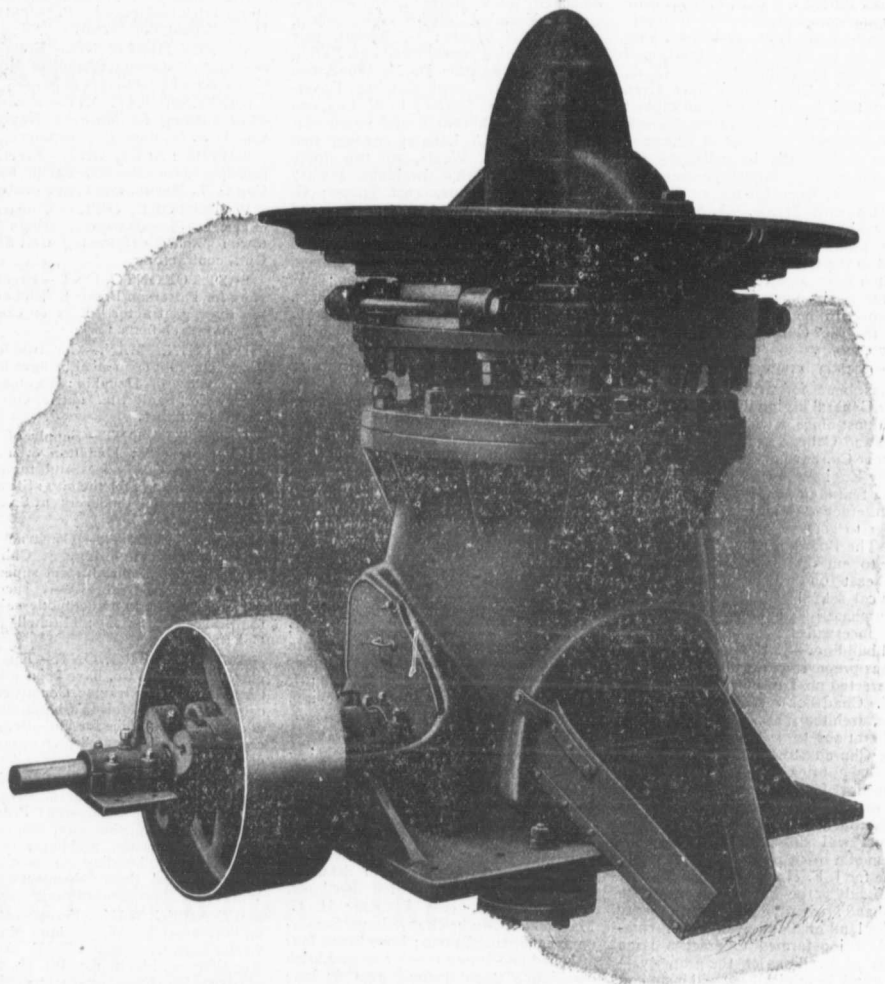


# Rock Crushing Plants
