And that the same has been, without sufficient authority, charged against the 35th G. III. which, however, your Committee are of opinion, ought to be authorised, or that the deficiency should, in future, be charged against that or any other unappropriated fund.—Your Committee have to remark, on the foregoing statement, that in the report ascertaining the first mentioned deficit, the gross amount of receipts are credited, and they have done the same in the above; subject, of course, to the decision of the House, if the sums paid there-out to Upper-Canada, should, or should not, be added to the amount deficient on both Statements, which is, however, of little moment, as it will only add to one Account, and diminish another.

Your Committee consider it their duty further to Report, that Duties to a considerable amount are levied under the Acts 6th Geo. II. and 4th and 6th Geo. III. of which no account is rendered to the House of Assembly, nor the amount applied to the support of the Civil Government of the Province, being, as your Committee are informed, remitted to Great Britain by the Officers of the Customs, and paid into His Majesty's Exchequer, which, if not contrary to the strict letter of the Law, appears to your Committee to militate against the spirit of the Declaration in the 18th Geo. III. Cap. 12th. recited in the 46th Clause of the Constitutional Act 31st Geo. III. Cap. 31st.

Your Committee finally Report, that the following sums remained in the Public Chest, on the 5th day of January, 1812, appropriated and unappropriated, viz :
