CAP. I.

An ACT to defray certain charges that have arisen for the support of Aged and Infant Paupers up to the First of February, 1840.

[Passed 28th February, 1840.]

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY,

WE, Your Majesty's dutiful and loyal subjects the Commons of Newfoundland, have freely and voluntarily resolved to give and grant to Your Majesty a Sum of Money to defray certain charges that have arisen for the support of Aged and Infant Paupers, up to the first day of February, in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty, and do humbly beseech your Majesty that it may be enacted, and— Preamble:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council, and Assembly of Newfoundland, in General Assembly convened, that from and out of such Monies as shall be and remain in the hands of the Treasurer of this Island, and unappropriated, there shall be granted unto Your Majesty Your Heirs and Successors, the Sum of Three Hundred and Fifty-three Pounds Seventeen Shillings and Seven Pence; which said Sum shall be drawn under the Warrant or Warrants of His Excellency the Governor, or Person administering the Government for the time being, and applied to the defrayal, up to the first day of February, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty, of the expenses incurred by the several Persons whose claims have been laid before the Assembly, and recommended to be discharged by message of His Excellency the Governor, in supporting Aged and Infant Paupers, and of such Sum of £353 17s. 7d. appropriated for the purposes of this Act.
