militia officers

Ranks of the directions hereinafter mentioned, and the officers fo appointed for the militia, within officers of fhall rank with the officers of fuch of his Majefty's forces, as may for the time His Majefty's being, ferve within this Province, as youngeft of their respective rank, which faid officers refpectively, shall within fix months after their feveral appointments. take the oath of allegiance to his prefent Majefty, his heirs and fucceffors, hefore the Magistrates affembled in quarter feffions, within the district to which iuch officers : efpectively belong.

U. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That it shall and may be lawful for the colonel or officer commanding any regiment or battalion of militia, and he is hereby required, to specify to each captain of a company of to be enrolled. his regiment or battalion, the limits from within which the militia men of luck captains company shall be enrolled.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That every male inbe enrolled in habitant from fixteen years of age to fix y, thall be deemed capable of beating arms, and thall enroll his name as a militia man on the first training day on which the faid companies shall be drawn out, in the division or limit in which his place of abode may be, and shall at such meeting give in his name, his a, e, and place of refidence, and if he has thereto but lately removed, he thail make the fame known, together with the place from whence he removed, and each Penalty for and every luch inhabitant, who fhall not attend and give in his name to the captain or officer commanding the company for fuch division or limit, fo that his name may be enrolled as a militia man, shall for fuch neglect forfeit and pay the fum of ten fhillings, to be recovered & applied in manner hereinalter mentioned. Provided neverthelefs that no inhabitant shall be convicted of the offence herein defcribed, unlefs it is proved at the time of trial, that the faid inhabitant had been notified, either perfonally, or by leaving a verbal notice at his usual place of abode, of the time of meeting, at leaft fix days previous Provided always, that no perfon above the age of fifty years, fhall to performabove the age of fifty. be called upon to bear arms, except on the day of annual meeting, or in time of war or emergency.

IV. Provided arways, and be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That the neglect of any perfonso to present himself for enrollment and exercite, shall not be construed to prevent the captain or officer commanding the company of militia of the limits wherein the place of relidence of any fuch perfon may be, from entering the name of fuch person, and such captain or officer commanding fuch company as aforesaid, is hereby required to enter the name of every fuch perfon, as thall come to his knowledge, upon the enrollment of his company, and when fo entered, every fuch person shall be fubject to perform all any every the like militia duties, and under the same penalties, as if he had personally presented himself for enrollment. Provided also, that if any difference shall arise between any captain or officer and any militia man, touching the age of such militia man, it shall be incumbent on the faid militia man to prove his age.

V. And be it further enacted by the authority a/orefaid. That the colonel or officer commanding each regiment or battalion, fhall on the fourth day of June in each and every year respectively, or in case it shall happen on a Sunday, then on the next day, and oftener, if he thinks it neceffary, call out the militia of fuch regiment or battalion, to be reviewed and exercised, and in his absence from the county, or in cafe of his removal or death, the faid militia shall be
