The printed preamble recites a joint declaration of the Provinces that the constitution of the railway is essential to the consolidation of Union, an obligation imposed by the Confederation Act and the Imperal Gaurantee Act. The termin of the milway are declared to be Rivers du Loup, in Canada, and Truro in Nova S. etia. The railway is declared to be a public work belonging to the Dominion, and to be made with a guage of five feet aix linches. The construction of the railway, and the management until completed, to be under four Commissioners appointed by Government, holding office during pleasure. The Chief Engineer to be apointed is to have a general superintendence of the works, under instructions from the Cammissioners.
