Illuminated Arc—Visible in all directions seaward.

Elevations—Height of light from H. W. to focal plane 221 1/2 feet. Height of tower from base to top of lantern, 27 1/2 feet.

Structures—The station comprises an octagonal wooden tower with sloping sides, and Keapers' dwelling, a one-story flat-roofed building, connected to tower by a covered passage way.

Color.—Red and White vertical stripes.
