Our Three Great Naval Victories.

On Tuesday, December 19, 1787, national thanksgiving was offered for three great victories won by the British Navy. There was a State proces sion along London Streets, and a service in St. Paul's Cathedral. The seamen and marines selected to escort their colours bore trophies of their bravery labelled "June, 1794." "February, 1797," or "October, 1797." On the earliest of these occasions, June 1, 1794 the Channel Fleet, under Richard Howe, created Earl Howe in 1788, captured six French ships; on the John Jervis, with the Mediterranean a depth of three feet. fleet of fifteen vessels, defeated the Spanish fleet of twenty-seven, off

Cape St. Vincent, capturing four ships, and disabling and sinking many others, and on the third, October 11, 1797, Admiral Adam Duncan defeated the Dutch Admiral John William de the Dutch Admiral John William d teen of his ships off Camperdown, on the north-west coast of Holland, where the memory of this defeat is om of calling it Kamp. ON A SEAT OF MARBLE WITH STEPS OF PURE GOLD.

It is made of pure white marble, and is no less than eighteen feet by ten feet wide. The actual seat is mounted on a large platform of the same material, and is upheld by fourteen spotless ivory pillars, carved in the shape of men and women; while the whole is covered with pictures

worked in the purest gold-leaf. Ascending to the platform is a staircase of solid gold, and in front of the monarch's seat is a magnificent silver fountain which continually sprays a stream of a very exquisite
