LOW GRADE ORE TREATMENT.

Reference has been made in the foregoing to the British Columbia Bullion Extracting Company, which has been the first plant of this kind in the province for the working of their process. The company is a private one, with its headquarters in London, and it holds the patent rights of the process throughout Canada. The principle of the Peletan-Cleric, as it is termed, method of extraction, consists briefly in the leaching out of the precious metals from their ores by the agency of cyanide of potassium and the precipitation of them by electrolysis.

The company has a record of 150 inches of water on Little Sheep creek and the plant will be led into the works by a box flume 1,000 feet long. The motive power of the plant will be electrically supplied by the Kootenay Power Company, whose plant is now being completed. The power supply wire from that company's sub-station to the B. C. Co. plant is now being installed. The plant together with the process is a very simple one, and has been working satisfactorily for some time. A FRESH GRIEVANCE.

Spain Says the United States Should Not Take Porto Rico After Peace Proposal. Threat to Publish Facts Affecting Further Evidence of American Perfidy. Washington, July 27.—The initiation of overtures for peace has had the effect of suspending in a large measure, for the time being at least, interest in the military and naval situation. Though it is known through the open admission of members of the administration that the present peace phase will remain unchanged until after another cabinet meeting of Friday, there was still evidence of a disposition to discuss the matter in every aspect. Naturally the first point of inquiry was the exact position taken by Spanish negotiation of yesterday. Curious in this point remained ungratified, and will probably be so for some time to come, it having been decided that nothing more definite than the statement issued from the White House last night should be given to the public at this time. The motive is a prudent one and the President has gone so far as to even suggest to the Madrid authorities the expediency of keeping the text of the Spanish overtures from publication until the peace negotiations are well advanced.
