every day's attendance. This indemnity shall be paid from the funds of the College. No Governor shall have a right to this indemnity unless he has faithfully attended to the affairs or deliberations of the Meeting until it has been duly closed.

CHAPTER IL

Officers of the College.

I. The officers of the College shall consist of a President, two Vice-Presidents, a Registrar and a Treasurer, and for each of the districts of Quebec and Montreal, of a Secretary; who shall be elected by ballot, by the Governors, from among their own body, and they shall continue in office until the ensuing Triennial Meeting; it being understood that the Treasurer and the Registrar shall reside either in the city of Quebec or of Montreal; and one of the Secretaries shall reside in Quebec and the other in Montreal; and should the President be absent at any meeting, the senior Vice-President shall exercise his duties, and in the event of both Vice-Presidents being absent, then a chairman shall be elected pro temp.

II. The President shall preside at all the Meetings of the College, and shall approve all accounts to be paid.

III. In the absence or in the event of the death of the President, the oldest Vice-President shall possess all his powers, and in the absence of the latter, the other Vice-President shall possess them.

IV. The President, may when he deems it expedient, by an order under his official signature nominate one or more persons, other than an officer of the College, to take legal proceedings against any person supposed to have infringed any of the provisions of the set, and also to collect all sums of money payable to the College by any person in virtue of this act.
