have asked the brotherhood to help them in building a house of worship in the North End.

End. What are we going to do about our Home Mission Work? We have accomplished something in the past year—perhaps more than the previous one—but we are not satis-fied—I am quite sure you are not. We have weak churches that need help. We should have an evangelist in the field all the time. The American Christian Missionary Socie-ty at the beginning of their Jubilee year

ty at the beginning of their Jubilee year put the amount to be raised for Home Missions, by the churches, at \$100,000 and they have reached that amount. Now, suppose we ask \$1,000.00 for Home Missions in these provinces, this year. Can we raise it? Let us try.

The American Christian Missionary Society continues its financial assistance to the church at Halifax and Pictou, and has expressed its willingness to help the church in Charlottetown, P. E. I. to the extent of \$150.00, provided this Board will do the same.

The Board recommends that \$150.00 be paid to the churches at Halifax, Pictou, and St. John (North end.)
