

University-to-university agreement for all disciplines. Within this exchange program up to four students from either university may participate. Applicants are expected to have second year standing and to achieve at least 580 points in the TOEFL Test.

The students from Germany are screened and selected by a committee of representatives from the "Akademisches Auslandsamt", the English Department and the department involved. Canadian students are selected by a similar committee.

The exchange program covers a tuition waiver and Canadian students may get a monthly accommodation support of DM 100 (N.B. rent levels in Eastern Germany are considerably lower than in Western Germany). Credits achieved at the partner university are accepted by the home university.

Students remain enrolled at their home university. Canadian students pay their usual home fees for the time of the exchange. German students usually receive leave status with a reduced fee. The exchange is normally for one year, but a shorter duration (half a year) is also possible.

This exchange program will begin operating in 1996.
