

(C) COMMONWEALTH AND FOREIGN GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES IN CANADA

His Excellency Pedro Castelblanco, Ambassador of Chile, left Ottawa on February 4 to return to Chile. In his absence, Mr. Carlos Crochard, Second Secretary of the Embassy, is Chargé d'Affaires ad interim. General Amalido Carrasco has been nominated as successor to Mr. Castelblanco.
