The Provincial Parks Act is under review to enable the strengthening of the existing legislation to reflect current policy.

# 3) Action Planned for 1992-93

The Minister of Natural Resources has announced his intention to represent 5 further site districts with new protected areas during the 1993 Ontario Provincial Parks Centennial. Consultations will be undertaken with Aboriginal peoples and the public regarding candidate sites.

# **OUEBEC GOVERNMENT PROGRESS**

#### 1) New Sites

- 18 provincial park reserves north of the 50th parallel, encompassing a total area of 57.372 km<sup>2</sup> were announced in the summer of 1992.
- 11 new Ecological Reserves were established in 1991-92.

## 2) Systems Planning Progress

- The moratorium on the creation of new provincial parks in Quebec was lifted.
- A 5-year plan outlining an implementation strategy for provincial parks based on natural areas representation was announced.

## 3) Action Planned for 1992-93

- Four parks will be created south of 50th parallel over the next 5 years: Mont Megantic, Reserve de Plaisance, Riviere Vasureal (Anticosti Island) and Massif du Mont Valin (at Saguenay-Lac Saint-Jean).
- 4 new parks north of the 50th Parallel will be created over the next 5 years: lac Albanel/rivière Temiscamie, cratère du Nouveau-Québec, monts Otish/monts Torngats, and rivière Koroc. These parks will be established after consultation with the local communities to ensure that they integrate with the James Bay Convention and Quebec North.
- Public hearings on the establishment of Mont Megantic Provincial Park will be completed by summer 1993.
