4. Final vear students failing in subjects not asgregating more than ajout $30, \%$ of the total obtainabie maris, need not repeat any of the courses, but are allowed to sit for special supplemental examinations in September of each vear, or for the regular examinations of another session.

5. Final year students whose failures aggregate more than the above, must repeat all final year subjects in which they have failed. They may also be called upon to repeat other subjects in which their standing was low. (1tay 26,1925.)
6. Students exempted from a cortain proportion of thoir work in any year, shall nevertheless be ranled with other students in that year, on a percentage basis calculatod on the subjects which they take. For example, assuming ten subjects in the course, a student exempted in one or more, and avcraging 60\% in all of the others, would rank equal with another student who averaged 60\% in all ten but when, in the opinion of the Dean, a student, owing to exemptions without corresponding handicaps, pursues a coursc which is appreciably lighter than that of the average studont in his vear, he may be ranked as though he had obtained only "pass" marts in the subjects in which he held exemptions: always provided, however, that an exempted student may, if he so desire, come up for examination in exempted subjects at the regular time and be entitled to whatevor marks he obtains.

7. In the caso of "optional"* course approved by the Faculty for insertion in the calendar, eredit may be given for standing obtained in accordanoe with the ordinary rule bascd upon lecture hours, but such credit shall in no caso rais the minimum number of marks required to pass in any yoar. (*The word "optional" has sinco acquired another meaningt (itar.5,191\%.)

Failures in drafting room and laboratory subjects in which it is not practicablo to set writton supplenental examinations, are divided into three classes:-

FF. Those obtaining less tian $30 \%$ of full marks.
F. Those obtaining less than $50 \%$ of full marirs, but not falling undor class PF.
D. Those obtaining 50\% or nore of full maris who are however, deficient in certain essential parts of their work. Tho mark "D" is to stand cpposite the student's name in the rocord until the deficioncy in question is mado up and the true mart can be entered.
