# Les Ecoles Ménagères Provinciales

## Montreal Technical School Building

The courses in Domestic Science organized by "Les Ecoles Menageres Provinciales" were instituted in 1904 by the Ladies' section of the St Jean Baptiste Society of Montreal, with the co-operation of a committee of gentlemen who took care of the financial end.

The Provincial Government admitting that those schools would be a help to the country by their high educational and moral teachings, grants them an annual subsidy, and provided for their installation in the building of the Montreal Technical School.

"Les Ecoles Menageres Provinciales" incorporated by an act of the Provincial Legislature, in June 1906, awards diplomas of Domestic Science to the successful candidates who have attended the regular normal course.

#### Courses

The Courses are divided in French in three sections:

- (A) The regular normal course for Domestic Science Teachers, from 15th. of September to 15th. June.
- (B) The vacation normal course for Lady Instructors, from 8th. July to 8th. August.
- (C) The public classes, from October first to the 30th. of April, given by teachers who have received their diplomas from Normal Schools in Paris, Fribourg, Switzerland, and Montreal.

The courses are composed of the following departments: Cooking, dressmaking, mending, fashion, fancy work, household science, washing and ironing; in addition classes in gardening, common law, and household book-keeping.

The classes in hygiene and practical medicine are given by a few of the learned professors of the Laval University. Sei
