

Wedding Etiquette.

Introductory. Our purpose in publishing this little booklet is to give our customers the prevailing customs pertaining to weddings, and to show them the correct styles of wedding invitations, cards, etc. Styles and customs for these important events, as in everything else, are constantly changing, and it is our purpose here to outline what is proper now. The groom's family and her family each makes out a list of guests.
