PUNCHED HOLES IN 10-IN. ARMOR. Sent Through The Plates And Si

New York, Jan. 19.—The reception test of the second lot of 10-inch armor piercing Holtzer shot was made yesterday at the Sandy Hook proving ground.

Two shots, weighing 575 pounds each, were fired from a coast defence gun at a 11 1-4-inch Harveyized steel plate, set 100 feet from the gun, with highly satisfactory

results.

The first shot was fired at the upper right portion of the plate, about two feet from an old perforation. The massive plate was pierced as if by an auger, and the shot, after cutting through the six feet of oak backing, buried itself in the sand cushion. Gauges and calipers were passed along the shot and failed to reveal the slightest variance in length or whickness of the steel bolt, in spite of the fact of its having been impelled gainst the plate at a velocity of 1625 feet a second by charge of over 183 pounds of powder.
