CITY FATHERS IN SESSION.

A SPECIAL MEETING AT WHICH LITTLE WAS ACCOMPLISHED.

The only discussion that amounted to anything was over Ald. Macdonald's motion to authorize the City Council to negotiate with the Toronto Railway Co. for the purpose of preparing a bill for consideration of the abolition of the present rate of fares.
