wards his accomplices were discovered. All three made full confession.

"The activities of these three spies has done great injury to the Fatherland and the army, as the two soldiers, especially Schmitzer, who was at the front, were able to give valuable information. The court martial condemned all three to death. The punishment was carried out soon after."
