BELGIAN ARMY NOW

Holding Firmly on Yser River; Few Square Miles Left of Nation

(Associated Press Correspondence)
Furnes, West Flanders, Dec. 29—
Sixty thousand worn soldiers strung along the Yser, where they checked the rush of the German invaders toward Pas de Calais, are all that are left of the Belgian army of 280,000 men under arms when Germany invaded Belgium. "We have no apologies to make for our artillery. Some idea of the value placed on our artillery is indicated by the fact that a Belgian captain of artillery was placed in command of 200 French guns and directed their fire continuously for thirty-six hours, in one of the fiercest artillery duels of the campaign.




