NEW SENATORS

The vacancies in the senate caused by the death of Senators William Dennis of Halifax and Peter McSweeney of Moncton have been filled by the appointment of John Stanfield of Truro and John A. McDonald of Amherst and Shediac, president of the Amherst Plastics Ltd. John A. McDonald was born in Point du Chene, the port of Shediac, about fifty-five years ago, the son of the late Edward McDonald. He was educated in the schools of Shediac and Westmorland county grammar school, learning in early life the mercantile business. Later he became established in the piano in-dustry, heading the Amherst Plastics, Limited, which has branches in Halifax, St. John and elsewhere. He is a director of the Atlantic Underwear Co. of Moncton and other concerns. Senator McDonald has acted as arbitrator in several important labor difficulties in the maritime provinces. He is well known in sporting circles, having pro-moted the maritime province rowing regatta at Shediac in 1919 and other amateur sports. He has homes in both Amherst and Shediac. Albert E. McDon-ald, St. John manager of the Amherst Plastics, Limited, is a brother, as is Wil-liam McDonald of Halifax, an attorney. Mrs. Bateman, wife of William Bateman, formerly C.N.R. station agent at Painsane Junction, is a sister. The new senator is a Roman Catholic and a Con-servative. He is married and has a family.

Colonel John Stanfield is the well known president of Stanfield Limited, Truro, and member of parliament for Colchester county from 1905 until 1917. For eight years he was chief government whip in the house of commons. He was born in 1868 at Charlottetown. He is a Conservative and an Anglican. His wife was Miss Sadie Yorston of Truro.
