Ostend, Belgium, Nov. 21—(By mail.)—Life of this usually lively city has been radically changed by the German military occupation. Inhabitants are forbidden to leave their houses between seven in the evening and seven in the morning, and no lights may be shown during that time. No one may leave town without passports from the German authorities.


