New York, May 28—Police reserves summoned yesterday to quell disturbances in West Thirty-Fourth street, alleged to have been caused by striking barbers, arrested seventeen on charge that they spat in the face of two aged barbers and their customers in the midst of a shave.

The seventeen were forced into an empty store nearby at the point of pistols before they surrendered. The 170 customers, still covered with lather, fled.

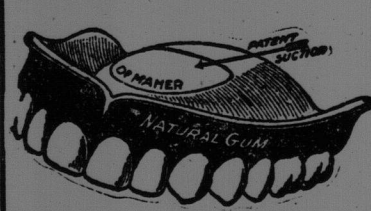

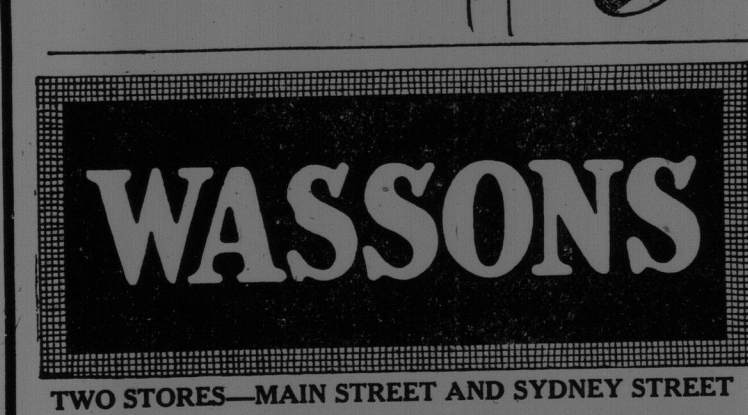
