The survey requested by the
Chief of the A. P. band appears to be
eminently desirable. I think there
should be no question that those portions
of the Reserve which have not been
heretofore subdivided should be surveyed
at the expense of the Govt.

There might be some question as
to whether the base lines of the River Lots
and the lines of Tp. 14 and 15 Range 4
should be retraced at the Govt. expense,
but as these surveys appear to have been
defined with monuments of a very perishable
nature I would recommend that this
portion of the required survey be also
made at the Govt. expense, and that
the whole be substantially moulded and
posted in accordance with the present
practice of the Dept. of the Interior. I
would also recommend that the
suggestion of the Agent that ~~cession~~
posts ~~be~~ be planted at the
centre of each section be carried out.

If it is not intended to appoint a surveyor
especially for this work the Ind. Comm. at Regina
might be asked to place this survey on his list to
be made by the officers under his instructions as soon
as it may be convenient for them to make it.
