JURY FINDS THAT FRED. ROBINSON DROWNED BY ACCIDENTAL DROWNING; THE CORONER REFERS TO THE CONFLICTING EVIDENCE

The inquest into the death of Frederick L. Robinson, who was drowned near the wharf at Westfield, on Sunday, the 20th inst., was conducted on Saturday afternoon by Coroner Ballantyne assisted by Cyrus F. Inches, of St. John, in the public hall, at Westfield. The evidence as expressed by the coroner, was very conflicting, especially that relating to the distance between the two boats when the accident occurred.

Ten witnesses were examined, consuming about three hours, after which the coroner Ballantyne briefly addressed the jury. The body, but not the cause, after about an hour of consideration brought in a verdict of accidental drowning. The First Witness. Louis G. Sinclair, who was with Robinson in the salmon boat was the first witness examined.
