New York, March 8.—Opening prices ranged from 4 to 7 points higher this morning in response to firmer cables and continued unfavorable weather reports. Heavy realizing during the morning checked upward tendency. But on reactions there was a good demand reflecting shroadening market and good support by bull intersts. The impression that the ngliBsh strike is upon the verge of settlemint has gained further head away and this expectation in connection with the continued unseasonable weather at the South is encouraging holders to stand firm and creating a broader demand for contracts. The immtdiate edvent of favorable weather would find the market "long", and considerably weaker from a technical point than a fortnight ago, but unless there is an early change to warmth and sunshine a further advance of considerable proportions is almost a foregone conclusion.
