

amount to such, instead of being subjected to the penalty aforesaid;—And any person charged with any act subjecting him to the penalty imposed by this section, may be arrested by order of the Magistrate before whom the complaint is made, upon affidavit shewing that there is reason to believe that such person is about to leave the Province, carrying any such arms, accoutrements or articles with him.

105. Any Officer or man of a Volunteer Militia Company who, when such Company is lawfully called upon to act in aid of the civil power, refuses or neglects to go out with such Company, or to obey any lawful order of his Superior Officer or of any Magistrate, shall thereby incur a penalty of twenty dollars for each offence.
