

MCLACHLIN, DANIEL, *J. P.* [*South Renfrew.*] *L.*

Was an extensive Lumber merchant for many years. Is a director of the Madawaska River Improvement Co., and of the Upper Ottawa Steamboat Co. Sat for Bytown in L. A., Can., from 1851 to 1854; and for Renfrew from g. e. 1861 until g. e. 1863. Was an unsuccessful candidate for Carleton at g. e. 1863. Elected to Commons for present seat at last g. e., by acclamation. Pop. 10,869.—*Arnprior, Ont.*

MCLELLAN, ARCHIBALD WOODBURY. [*Colchester.*] *L.*

Ancestors came from the North of Irel. S. of the late G. W. McLellan, Esq., who sat in the N. S. Legislature for a lengthened period. B. at Londonderry, N. S., Dec., 1824. Ed. there and at Mount Allison Wesleyan Academy. M., 1854. Miss Caroline Metzler, of Halifax. A director of the Cobequid Marine Insurance Co. Sat for Colchester in L. A. of N. S., from 1858 until 1863, and for Northern Colchester from latter date until the Union. Returned to Commons at last g. e. Pop. 20,045. No. of voters, 3,358.—*Londonderry, N. S.*
