## BILL.

An Act to substitute Yearly Returns for the Quarterly Returns required of Clergymen and others, by the sixteenth Section of the Census Act.

WHEREAS it is unnecessary that the Preamble. Returns hereinafter mentioned should he made oftener than once in each year: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

5 And it is hereby enacted, by the authority of the same, That for and notwithstanding any Certain Rething in the sixteenth section of an Act turns required passed in the Session held in the tenth and Vict. c. 14, to eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and be made only 10 intituled, " An Act for taking the Census of " this Province, and obtaining Statistical in-"formation therein," the Registry in the said section mentioned, shall be forwarded by the person by whom it shall have been kept, 15 to the proper Clerk of the Peace, or City or Town Clerk, within five days after the first day of January in each year, and not oftener.

And be it enacted, That so long as while the the Act last above mentioned shall remain Cousus Act shall be in 20 in force, it shall not be necessary that any force certain Minister, Clergyman, or Justice of the Returns not be required. Peace, should return to any Clerk of the Peace, the list of the marriages by him solemnized, required by the sixth Section of the 25 Act of the Legislature of Upper Canada, passed in the eleventh year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, and intituled, "An Act to make valid certain " Marriages heretofore contracted, and to 30 " provide for the future selemnization of Mu-"trimony in this Province," any thing in the said Section to the contrary notwithstanding.
