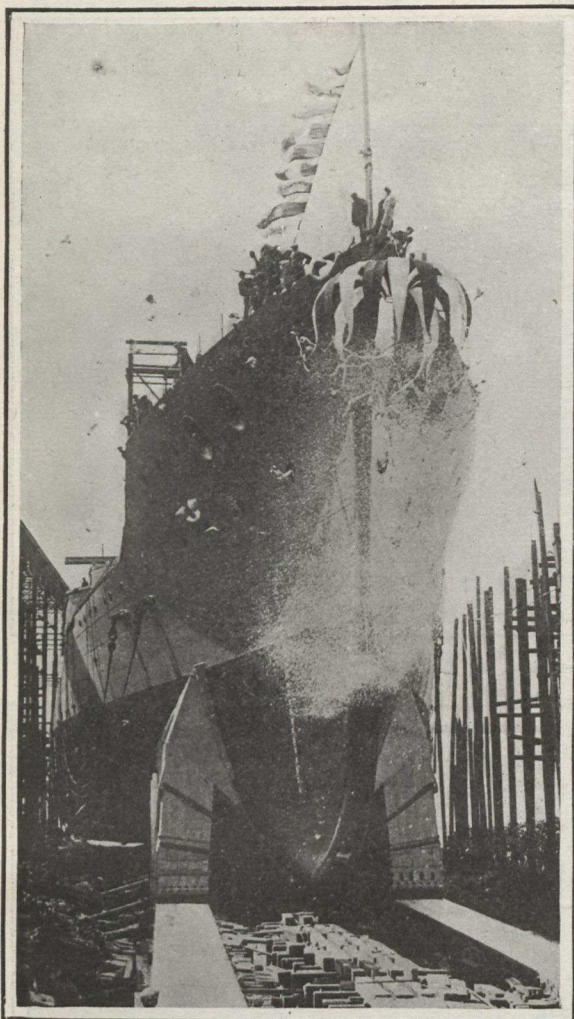

Japanese Battle Cruiser "Kongo," Launched at Barrow, Scotland. Cost \$10,000,000; Displacement 27,500 tons



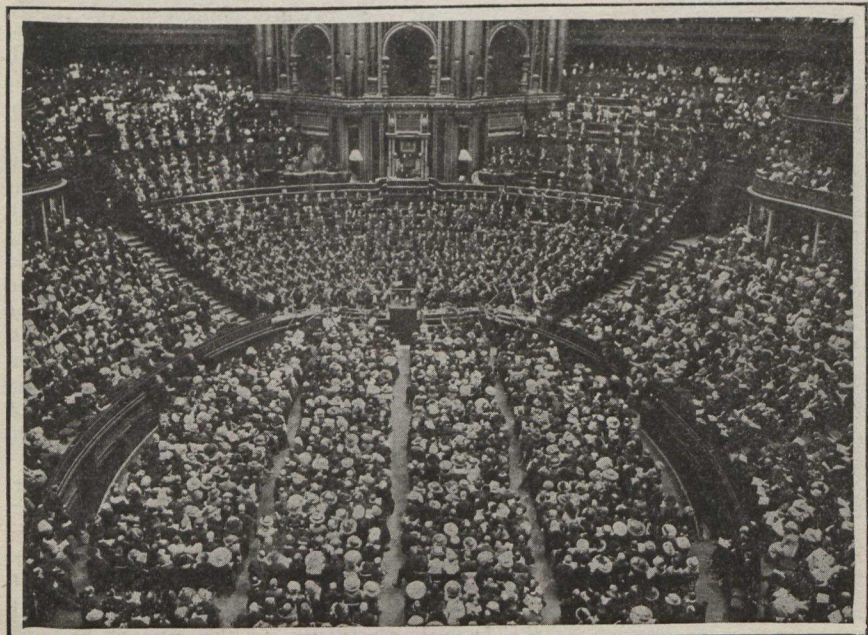
