On the matter of the Queen against Malcolm Fraser

Whereas Malcolm Fraser of the Township of Tuscarora
yeoman did in the twenty eighth day of March last prefer his
Petition unto this Court setting forth among other things a
conviction of him the said Petitioner by David Johnson and
Charles Bain Esquires two of the Commissioners under and by
virtue of an Act of the Parliament of the late Province of Upper
Canada passed in the Second year of Her Majesty's reign
intituled "An Act for the protection of the Lands of the Crown
in this Province from trespass and injury" and also an
Act of the Parliament of the Province of Canada passed in
the twelfth year of Her Majesty's reign intituled "An Act to
explain and amend an Act of the Parliament of the late
Province of Upper Canada passed in the second year of Her
Majesty's Reign intituled 'An Act for the protection of the Lands
of the Crown in this Province from trespass and injury' and
to make further provision for that purpose" setting forth
also a notice of appeal therefrom to this Court pursuant
to the said Acts and praying this Court to annul the
decision of the said Commissioners or to order such further
enquiry to be made or to direct such issue at Law to be
tried as to this Court should seem meet And that the
said Commissioners may be ordered to pay to the said
Petitioner his costs in the matter aforesaid and in this appeal
or to make such order and direction as to the said costs as
to this Court should seem meet Now upon motion this day
made unto this Court by Mr Wilson of Counsel for our
Sovereign Lady the Queen in this matter and upon hearing
the said Petition read and Mr Cooper of Counsel for the
said Petitioner appearing and consenting thereto this Court
doth dismiss the said Petition of Appeal with costs to be
paid by the said Petitioner to the Solicitor of our Sovereign
Lady the Queen in this matter and it is hereby referred to
the Master of this Court to tax the said costs
