Gentlemen, -

With further reference to your letter of the 24th instant in the matter of lot 6, Con. 1, Tuscarora, I beg to inform you that it appears from the records of the Department that you have been misinformed and that the true facts are that after full and careful investigation by the Indian Agent at which William Creen was represented by counsel, and after consideration of the evidence and report thereon by the Law Clerk of the Department it was decided that Sarah Catherine Wood was entitled to the above property, that the lot was located to her by the council of the band and a location ticket issued to Mrs. Wood by the Department, and that consequently no action by the Department is called for.
