
Ottawa, 19th May, 1905.

In reference to your letter of the 9th instant in which you state that the Indians are building their fences upon the road allowance thereby making the usual width of the road less than 66 feet, I beg to say that the Indians have no right to encroach on the road.

The Department approves of the action of the Council in deciding that all fences must be removed to the proper line.
