
Revd Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 16th instant, regarding the brick and stone which you ordered for the Qu'Appelle Industrial School building, I beg to inform you that you should not have given an order for brick to any other than Mr C. Peltier, without first communicating with the Department and obtaining instructions. The Department should also have been written to before you purchased the stone and had the same hauled.

It is hoped that you will not again act without authority in connection with the erection of this building. Purchases made from parties other than those mentioned by the Department will not be considered.

Vouchers may be forwarded for the brick and stone which you have bought, but the Department will not in future consider any vouchers for unauthorized expenditure.
