even be sufficient, if more cannot be obtained.) If you concur, I shall be obliged if you will be good enough to inform me where a piece of land can be obtained that will be suitable for the purpose. If possible vacant land should be selected; an effort will then be made to obtain it from the Department of the Interior.
