Sir,

The Department has repeatedly requested you to furnish details of Timber Returns covered by the Dues sent in from time to time, from your Agency, and have called your attention on several occasions to the necessity of making prompt collections and forwarding Affidavits for all Timber cut on the Reserve.

In connection with the foregoing, I must ask you to state immediately, what Dues the amount of \$61.72 sent in February 22nd 1913, and also the amount of \$50.00 sent in July 24th, 1913, covers.
