ex-pupils amount to only \$5000,000. You will, therefore, readily understand that the Department must exercise discretion in granting authority for expenditure. Only those ex-pupils who have recently left school can be aided and the amount in question must cover the assistance extended to girls as well as to the boyse. It is desired to refer you in this connection to circular letter of March 12, 1914, which stipulates that assistance can only be afforded to recent graduates of schools.
