in that he,

at Debert Camp, Nova Scotia, at 1030 hours on the 17th of August, 1942, absented himself without leave from his unit, Les Fusiliers de Sherbrooke, C.A., until he was apprehended by the Military Authorities at Montreal, Quebec, at 1910 hours on the 10th of December, 1943, dressed in civilian clothes.

ABSENTING HIMSELF WITHOUT LEAVE,

in that he,

at Montreal South, Quebec, at 0310 hours on the 28th of December, 1943, absented himself without leave from his unit, No. 4 District Depot, C.A., until he was apprehended by the Military Authorities at Laprairie, Quebec, at 0145 hours on the 27th of May, 1946, dressed in civilian clothes.
