

The accused was cautioned as follows:

Q: Do you wish to make any statement or to give evidence on oath
you are not obliged to say anything or give evidence unless
you wish to do so, but whatever you may or any evidence you give
will be taken down in writing and may be given in evidence.

A: I want to make a statement

Q: On oath or not on oath?

A: On oath.

The accused sworn states:

"I left the Field punishment camp on thursday night. I think it was the 23 or 24 I'm not sure. I slept in Kloot that night. Then I came down to Brussels the next day and I met Mme Simon and she make me an invitation for supper and I've been there for supper. I went there for supper next day and I sleep there. I left the house about 11.30 or 12.00 o'clock and I was drunk and don't remember what's happened after that until I'm being woken up."

The accused does not wish to call witnesses at this point.
