


- 1st Charge Absent without leave from 1200 hours 1 August 1942 until
Sec 15 (1) reporting to the C.M. Police at Hull at about 2100 hours
A.A. on 13 August 1942.
- 2nd Charge On or about 31st July 1942 did steal goods, i.e. 15 lbs.
Sec. 18 (4) Cocoa, 34 lbs. Coffee, 29 lbs. Jam, 2 lbs. Margarine,
A.A. 1 lb. Cheese, 2 lbs. Butter, 2 tins Mulo-beef, 5 tins
Sardines, 3 tins Herrings, 2 tins Milk, 6 tins Meat &
Veal Paste, 2 lbs. Golden Syrup, 1 tin Stewed Steak, 1
tin Pork & Beans, 1 tin Meat and 1 package Egg Powder
valued at £12 - 4 - 5 public property from the Regimental
Mess contrary to the Army Act.
