Dear Sir:-

I observe from your October report that when you visited the Kincolith Indians they complained about non-settlement for the timber damaged by the Granby Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company, and apparently it was not until your return that you received my letter relative to this matter dated the 17th of October, as in your reply of the 29th you stated you thought it advisable to defer the visit for the discussion of this subject until all the Indians were back after their hunting expeditions, which you thought would be about the end of November.

I hope you will be able to have another meeting with these Indians to discuss this matter at an early date, as I am extremely desirous of endeavouring to obtain a settlement of the claim.
