

the church. He shall have the general charge of the school, and shall be the executive officer thereof. He shall report annually to the church.

- (2) An assistant-superintendent, who shall act in the place of the superintendent during his absence and at other times shall perform such duties as the Superintendent may assign him.
- (3) A Secretary, who shall keep the records of all the meetings and a roll of the members of the school, and shall perform such other duties as pertain to his office.
- (4) A Treasurer, who shall have charge of the funds of the school and shall keep an accurate account of their receipt and expenditure. He shall disburse the funds of the school only when authorized by the Superintendent, as the representative of the school and in accordance with the school's vote.
- (5) A Librarian, who shall have charge of the library, and shall select and purchase all books under the direction of the Pastor and Superintendent.

3. The above officers with the Pastor shall constitute an Executive Committee, who shall assist the Superintendent in the management of the school.
