NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN—

1. That the Annual Examinations of the Institute of Actuaries will be held in the Colonial centres, Melbourne, Sydney, Adelaide, Brisbane, Wellington, Montreal, Toronto, Ottawa, Winnipeg, and Cape Town, and also in Calcutta, from Monday, 20th April, to Saturday, 25th April, 1914, inclusive.
2. That the respective Local Superintendents will fix the hours of the Examinations, and inform the Candidates thereof and of the address at which they will be held.
3. That Candidates must give notice in writing to the Honorary Secretaries in London, England, and pay the prescribed fee of one guinea, not later than 31st January, 1914.
4. That Candidates who have passed Part I of a previous Syllabus will be permitted to take the Third Paper of Part I of the Syllabus dated 18 June, 1908, as a separate Examination, and will not be required to pay an Examination Fee.
5. That Candidates must pay their current annual subscription prior to 31st December 1913.
