Some time ago through the medium of the newspapers the citizens in general were advised that on account of the great advance in prices and demand of prompt payments by the Wholesale, that unless customers settled their accounts in full either weekly, bi-weekly, or at the end of each month, the retail grocers and butchers of Brantford would have to adopt strictly cash basis. This notice apparently has not been paid much attention. The Grocers and Butchers have always been very lenient with their customers and many times to their own sorrow. This must be changed if they themselves are to remain in business. No merchant wishes to humiliate his customers by personally bringing this to their attention, but the Association in general propose to adopt "Cash Only" unless there is a very marked change in payments before the first of the year.

CHILD SAVED MOTHER FROM SUFFOCATION

Mrs. J. E. Townson and Her Young Son Had Narrow Escape From Coal Gas

When the young son of Fireman J. E. Townson, 16 Bruce Street, woke up at three o'clock this morning for a glass of milk, he saved the life of his mother, who was overcome by the fumes escaping from a coal stove. The youngster usually awakes at this time for a drink, and when he had several times called unsuccessfully for his mother, he rose from bed and attempted to waken her. It was only after repeated efforts, and after striking Mrs. Townson on the face, that she was aroused, and was able to stagger to the kitchen where she collapsed. Reviving after a time, the unfortunate woman made her way to the door which she opened, and again fell headlong in the snow.
How long she lay here unconscious is unknown, but it was after four o'clock when the neighbors in the house next door became aware of her condition, and summoned a doctor.
The boy was probably saved, and the lives of both preserved, by the practice he had of sleeping with his head under the coverings, a habit which in this instance was undoubtedly responsible for the saving of two lives from death by asphyxiation.
