American Ultimatum Regarding the Philippines.

NEWS TOPICS OF A WEEK.

Important Events in Few Words For Busy Readers.

PARIS, Nov. 22.—The Spanish and American Peace Commissioners met in joint session at 10 o'clock yesterday afternoon. The Americans declared the United States must have the entire Philippine archipelago, and for a treaty cession of the islands, the Americans tendered to Spain \$20,000,000.

It is further declared that it is the purpose of the United States to maintain the Philippine Islands as an "open door" to the world's commerce.

On the terms named, the United States proposes a mutual relinquishment of all claims for indemnity in law or equity, subsequent to the outbreak of the last Cuban insurrection.

Nov. 23 is fixed as the date on which the United States Commission desires a definite response to yesterday's proposition, and all other matters in issue here.

It is also declared that the United States desire to treat of the religious freedom of the Philippine Islands, as agreed upon between the United States and Spain in 1898, and also of the acquisition of the Philippine Islands for an American naval station, and of cable landing rights at other places in Spanish jurisdiction, and a review of the Spanish-American treaties as heretofore.

The meeting was then adjourned until Wednesday.

THE SEALING FLEET.

Return of the Valentines to Washington—The Canadian Wagon—The Labor Law and Canada.

Washington, Nov. 23.—Capt. Thayer, representing the Manufacturers' Association of the British Columbia sealing fleet, returned to Washington yesterday, bringing with him ample data on which to base their reports as to the value of the seal. THINKS PHILIPPINES WILL NOT AGAIN SUBMIT TO COLONIAL GOVERNMENT.

LONDON, Nov. 23.—Agoncillo, the agent of Aguinaldo, with his advisers, returned here from Manila yesterday, and is very indignant at the statements of Major-General Wemyss, in reply to an arrangement of the Philippine Commission, and the general situation is displeasing to him.
