

SIX MILLION JEWS ARE FACING DEATH

Starvation and Disease Cause Indescribable Suffering in Eastern Europe.

The hardships of this winter will mean death to thousands of Jews in Poland, unless outside aid intervenes at once according to a recent statement of the American Red Cross Commission to Poland, recently returned to the United States after months of relief work in eastern Europe.

He painted a vivid picture of this starving people, clad in rags, who are now creeping back toward their devastated homes after months of wandering, and dying of starvation and typhus along the roads, as they go.

Outside starvation, numerous diseases, attributed to malnutrition and lack of food, have killed men and women and children like flies," he said.

The Red Cross and the American Jewish Relief agencies are doing their utmost to keep both the Jews and the Gentiles in these stricken lands alive.

The saddest thing in all Eastern Europe at the present moment—worse than all the other instances of starvation and even of death and disease on every hand—is the children who are seen outside of the bakeries that are able to keep going in Warsaw.

As an appeal for funds is to be made in Ontario and a generous response from this district is confidently expected.

More money is needed to help feed these children, and an appeal soon to be made in Canada for that purpose.

Oldest Account of Creation of Man

It is known, of course, that the first account of the Fall of Man was written a great many years after the event. Hitherto the account given in the Pentateuch has been presumed to be the first story. It now appears that there was at least one other version of the event written long before the first word of the Bible was put on papyrus or carved on stone.

The probable date of the tablets is 3,000 B.C., and they are the work of the Sumerians. This race took its name from the southern portion of Babylon, which was called Sumer before the invasion of the Semites.

The tablets indicate that the Sumerians had a conception of the mother of a god as one to whom intercession might be made, and Dr. Langdon refers to "scenes so common on Babylonian seals where the mother goddess stands in intercession before the god, with one or both hands raised in supplication, and the left foot advanced as though about to set it upon the paved approach to the throne of the deity."

The tablets, having been inscribed with uniform script, were baked and thus became as durable almost as concrete, so that after five thousand years they were perfectly legible to the interpreters.

It is interesting to note, too, that the further exploration is made in the history of religion the more numerous and elaborate were the ceremonies connected with worship, family and the inevitability of human suffering are to be detected in all the tablets which concern religion.

With the Sumerians he was called Dungi, the god-man, a divinely-born king sent by the gods to restore the lost paradise. Their practise was to seek to placate the wrath of the gods and assuage the sorrow of the earth-mother by means of song.
