ACTIVE BYRNE VISITS SHIRLEY HOME.

Head Constable John Byrne, who spent a brief vacation in the United States, returned home by Tuesday's express, and had a very enjoyable and interesting trip. Whilst away he attended the International Police Chiefs' conference at the City Hall, New York, where he met all the police chiefs from all parts of the world, and had assembled for a four day's conference on police subjects. Every day was extended by the New York City Police, so that he was able to inspect the different police departments and prisons and gain valuable information as to their methods. At the conclusion of the conference, Head Constable Byrne took in the Sports held at the Jamaica Race Course, N.Y., on Sept. 16th. He then proceeded to Boston and while there he attended the courtesy of Mr. Herbert Parsons, Deputy Commissioner of Police for Boston, he visited the Industrial School at Shirley for boys, aged 15 years, the Concord Reformatory for young men, the Girls Industrial School, Lancaster, Mass., and the Industrial School for girls from 17 to 21 years, all of which were very kindly received by the Superintendent and given all the information possible as to their methods. He was particularly struck by the Industrial School at Shirley, where of Supt. G. P. Campbell, as a result of his visit to the place, he has decided to have a similar school in St. John's. The place is situated about 40 miles out of Boston, and occupies 950 acres of land, and is cultivated and the land produces sufficient vegetables, butter, and meat and eggs for the requirements. Four neat stone houses provide living quarters for inmates. At present there are 250 boys on the place. On entering, they are classified according to their age and education and placed at work either in Manual Training Departments, which form part of the institution, or at the farm. Boys will not reform may be held there for 21 years old, but it is the intention of the system to state that this is rarely necessary. Ten is the minimum time for boys who are allowed on parole, and five percent don't have to be back after the first term. There are 900 boys from this institution in all of these reports to their effect every month, so that a boy kept on their conduct. There are only five of six officials employed in the institution, and so well managed that it is more than half self-sufficient. The secret of its success, according to Head Constable Byrne, is that a boy misbehaves, privileges are withheld, and he is separated from the other boys, until he realizes that it pays best to be good. Good food, wholesome food, healthy surroundings, and above all, kindness, an insistence on orderly habits, the cardinal points of Shirley Industrial Home. Head Constable Byrne is so much pleased with this institution, that he secured quite a collection of valuable data in connection with it, and he has information to anyone who is interested in our own problem. Mr. Byrne accompanied her father on his vacation. She has now gone to the Royal Victoria Hospital, to take up the nursing profession.

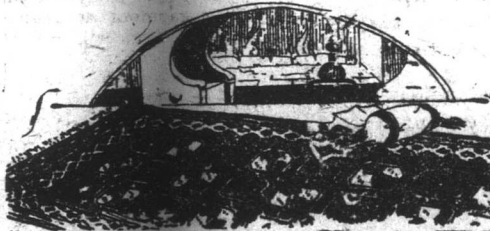
