CONVENTION BETWEEN HIS MAJESTY IN RESPECT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM AND HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF THE BELGIANS SUPPLEMENTARY TO THE CONVENTION OF JUNE 21, 1922, TO FACILITATE THE CONDUCT OF LEGAL PROCEEDINGS.

His Majesty the King of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions leyond the Seas, Emperor of India, and His Majesty the King of the Belgians, desirous of supplementing the Convention concluded between them for the purpose of facilitating the conduct of legal proceedings which was signed at london on the 21st June, 1922;

Have resolved to conclude a Convention for this purpose and have appointed their Plenipotentiaries:

His Majesty the King of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions the Seas, Emperor of India:

For Great Britain and Northern Ireland:

His Excellency the Right Honourable Earl Granville, his Ambassador Extra-Ordinary and Plenipotentiary at Brussels; and

His Majesty the King of the Belgians:

M. Paul Hymans, his Minister of Foreign Affairs;

who, having communicated their full powers, found in good and due form, have agreed as follows:

## I.—PRELIMINARY

## ARTICLE 1

In this Convention the words:

(1) "territory of one (or of the other) High Contracting Party" shall be interpreted as meaning at any time any of the territories of such High Contracting Party to which the Convention at that time applies;

(2) "subject of one (or of the other) High Contracting Party" shall be deemed-

### ARTICLE 2

# Security for Costs

The subjects of one High Contracting Party resident in the territory of the other subjects of one High Contracting Party resident in the territories subjects shall not be obliged to give security for costs in any case where the subjects shall not be so obliged in similar subjects of the latter High Contracting Party would not be so obliged in similar circumstances.
