

ARTICLE VII

The Canadian Government and the Hungarian Government shall cooperate in all matters affecting the operation of this Agreement and to that end:

- (1) At the request of the Canadian Government and in order to assist them to determine for the purpose of the distribution of the sum mentioned in Article I any claims of Canadian citizens, the Hungarian Government shall supply to the Canadian Government free of expense all available particulars which are held by the appropriate Hungarian authorities and which have not already been supplied to the Canadian Government concerning any claims which are the subject of this Agreement, as well as copies of the various Hungarian measures mentioned in that Article.
- (2) At the request of the Hungarian Government, the Canadian Government shall supply such particulars as are then held by them concerning the individual claims of Canadian citizens under Article I. Additionally, the Canadian Government shall provide the Hungarian Government, after the distribution mentioned in Article V, with a list showing the payments which have been made.

ARTICLE VIII

This Agreement comes into force upon the date of signature.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, being duly authorized thereto by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement.
