The Department will, after consultation with the necessary Canadian Government departments, refer all official requests which meet the criteria outlined in the Regulations (see Annex III) to the Decorations Committee and subsequently convey the Committee's decision to the mission of the government concerned.

(c) <u>Canadian Protocol</u>

The Office of the Chief of Protocol, Department of External Affairs, is ready at all times to assist and advise missions in protocol matters. Missions may however be interested to know of two guides:
